<2024 Fall>Application Guideline for Student Exchange

1. Overview

With the keywords "Learn in Asia, Learn with Asia", CAMPUS Asia Student Exchange Program has been restarted from 2022 Fall. Under the theme of "Social Innovation Program for Promoting Dialogue of Civilizations and Fostering Cultural Intelligence in Contemporary Asian Societies", four universities in Japan, China, South Korea, and ASEAN (Waseda University, Peking University, Korea University and Nanyang Technological University) work together for the development of "Social Innovators" who can create positive changes to the social issues of current diverse societies.

In addition to taking social science courses at host university while on study abroad, opportunities such as a learning system in which students from four universities connect and learn together through CAMPUS Asia mutual courses are also planned.

Peking University

Peking University is a national public research university in China founded in 1898. Considered to be the most difficult university to enter in China, Peking University has produced the most notable politicians in the country as well as many notable alumni in other fields. With a collection of 7.03 million books, the Beijing University Library is known as the largest university libraries in Asia.



Eligible Students:

Those enrolled at Waseda University as full-time undergraduate degree-seeking students

Note 1) Must be enrolled at Waseda University during study abroad period.

Note 2) Please note that due to the regulations of host university, students with Chinese nationality are not eligible for this program.

Approximately 3

Study Abroad Period:

September 21, 2024 - March 31, 2025 (1 Semester) or

September 21, 2024 – September 20, 2025 (1 year)

Note 3) Actual commencement date is planned to be in mid-August as per academic calendar of host university.

Enrollment Status:

Study Abroad (Study Abroad period will be counted in the number of years of school attendance only if the credits obtained during study abroad are approved as credits toward graduation.)

**Please consult with your school office as the treatment may differ depending on the school.*

Tuition:

Designated tuition of Waseda University during study abroad period. (Collected by Waseda University based on the principle of mutual tuition fee exemption.)

Other Expenses:

Travel expenses, accommodation fees, living expenses, overseas travel insurance fee (it is **mandatory to purchase the insurance designated by Waseda University**), etc. (All paid at students' expense.)

CAMPUS Asia Program as a Whole

In addition to the student exchange program, the followings are (or planned to be) offered.

-Setting up courses dedicated to CAMPUS Asia

-Lectures/seminars in which partner universities connect online and learn together.

-Holding a Social Innovation Forum where students from four universities gather at one partner university to discuss social issues and problem-solving. Basically, travel expenses and accommodations fees are subsidized or paid by the program. Waseda university students are also required to make presentation regarding their study and research conducted during the exchange program at the time of Social Innovation Forum and submit the report after the forum.

3. Eligibilities

- 1) Those enrolled at Waseda University as full-time undergraduate degree-seeking students during the study abroad period.

Note 5) Please note that due to the regulations of host university, students with Chinese nationality are not eligible for this program.

- 2) Those who have an interest in CAMPUS Asia theme "Social Innovation Program for Promoting Dialogue of Civilizations and Fostering Cultural Intelligence in Contemporary Asian Societies".
- 3) Those who have sufficient English proficiency to follow lectures at host university (TOEFL iBT 80, IELTS 6.0 or more or equivalent).
- 4) Those who can study and work on cross-cultural understanding with enthusiasm at host university.
- 5) Those with outstanding academic records.
- 6) Those who can travel following the designated schedule.

7. Scholarship

Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO) Scholarship of 60,000 yen per month may be provided. However, please note that there are certain requirements for applying for JASSO scholarship, such as nationality (Japanese nationals or those permitted to reside permanently in Japan), family financial status, GPA, receiving other scholarships at the same time, etc.
