1. School Life



I recommend you go to an exchange student social party organized by Waseda. I still keep in touch with the friends I met at the party!




Alternatively, take advantage of the club fair period, which runs during March and April. Go to the club welcome, see the club, and join the club.


Shinkansen is also eligible for student discount, so get a student discount document from school and travel all over Japan.
